Tizz Rolls Sheet 1

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A Tizz Roll is the movement used by drummers to create a smooth sounding accented roll. The name is often associated with a four stroke accented roll, however it applies to any accented roll.

The tizz sound can be thought of as playing an accent and a gracenote, as in a flam, except the grace note is a buzz and played quickly AFTER the accented note and not before. When accented rolls are played correctly and at tempo, there should be no audible gap between the accented note and the start of the roll sound.
